The Hospice Eligibility Report provides detailed metrics on patients who did not have a hospitalization or emergency department visit prior to electing hospice, including Name, Medical Record Number, Branch, Referral Type, Referral Source, Start of Care, Start of Episode, Length of Stay, Primary DX, Secondary DX, Level of Care, Admitting Clinician, Case Manager, and related Coordination Notes.

The question of hospice eligibility is one of the most frequently targeted issues in regulatory enforcement. Hospice organizations are under increasing legal and regulatory scrutiny related to medical necessity complaints under the False Claims Act and the closely related anti-kickback statute.
